

THE RENAL ASSOCIATION

MINUTES of the First General Meeting held on the 30th March, 1950.

1. On the proposal of Professor Franklin, Dr. Osman was elected Founder President and he took the Chair.
2. Thirty Members were present.
3. The President in a brief statement reviewed the origin and aims of the Association.
4. It was agreed that the business of the Association should be conducted by an Executive Committee consisting to begin with, of:
The President, Mr. G.J. Sophian, (Hon. Secretary),
Mr. F.J.F. Barrington, Professor Franklin,
Dr. W.W. Payne and Mr. D.F. Ellison Nash, with power to increase the numbers if and when necessary.
5. It was agreed that the title of the Association should be "The Renal Association".
6. It was agreed that Meetings should be held when possible on the last Wednesday and Thursday alternately, in the months of January, April, July and October.
7. It was agreed that by courtesy of the Ciba Foundation meetings should be held at the rooms of the Foundation at 4.30 p.m. when possible.
8. Mr. D.F. Ellison Nash read a paper on "Form and Function in the Renal Tract - A Review and Prospect," which was greatly appreciated and after a brief discussion the Meeting adjourned.
